Program of the Year

The Program of the Year award is divided into (3) three categories based on the population served: Internal, Emory Community, and External; (1) one student organization will be awarded per category. Eligible programs could include a one-time event, a semester-long series, or a continued tradition. This award seeks less to recognize events of high volume and more of those with greatest impact.

External

Programs eligible for the External Program of the Year award were put on by a student organization at Emory University to benefit a community beyond Emory University. This event allowed the student body to experience an off-campus location in an enjoyable and organized fashion.

To what extent does the evidence illustrate a strong program design, yielding a positive and seamless experience for both the student body and the external community? Consider how well-organized was the program in facilitating a positive and seamless experience for both the student body and the external community?

Engagement with Off-Campus Location

To what extent did the program enable meaningful engagement with the off-campus location? Consider how effectively the program showcased the unique aspects of the external community to the Emory University student body.

Innovation and Creativity in Program Design

To what extent did the program demonstrate innovative and creative elements? Consider how well the program stood out in terms of its unique approach to providing an off-campus experience.
