Scoring Rubric

To what extent does the graduate student organization exemplify a commitment to the betterment and strengthening of Emory and/or the greater Atlanta community? Assess the organization's efforts and impact in contributing to the improvement of Emory and the broader Atlanta community.

To what extent have the hosted programs and/or events reflected the organization's mission? Evaluate the alignment between the organization's mission and the nature and content of its programs and events.

To what extent has the organization demonstrated a commitment to professional excellence? Assess the organization's dedication to maintaining high standards of professionalism in its activities and operations.

To what extent has the organization demonstrated creativity in its programs and events? Evaluate the innovative approaches and creative elements incorporated by the organization in its programs and events.

To what extent has the organization shown a commitment to social justice? Assess the organization's initiatives and actions that contribute to promoting social justice and equity.

To what extent does the organization embody the Emory spirit through its commitment to leadership development, collaboration amongst groups, and programs to enhance campus life? Evaluate the organization's active involvement in leadership development, collaboration, and programs that enhance the overall quality of campus life at Emory.
