To what extent has the student organization demonstrated significant growth since its recent establishment on campus? Evaluate the extent of the organization's growth in terms of membership, activities, and overall impact on the campus community.

To what extent has the organization increased its presence around the Emory campus? Assess the visibility and influence of the organization across different aspects of campus life.

To what extent has the organization achieved the goals outlined during the chartering process? Evaluate the organization's success in fulfilling the objectives set forth during its establishment.

To what extent has the organization gained more members? Consider the extent to which the organization has expanded its membership, reflecting its appeal and relevance.

To what extent has the organization created new staple events on campus? Assess the organization's ability to introduce new and impactful events that contribute to campus life.

To what extent does the evidence predict that the organization is here to stay? Consider the organization's demonstrated long-term sustainability, stability, and potential for continued success.
